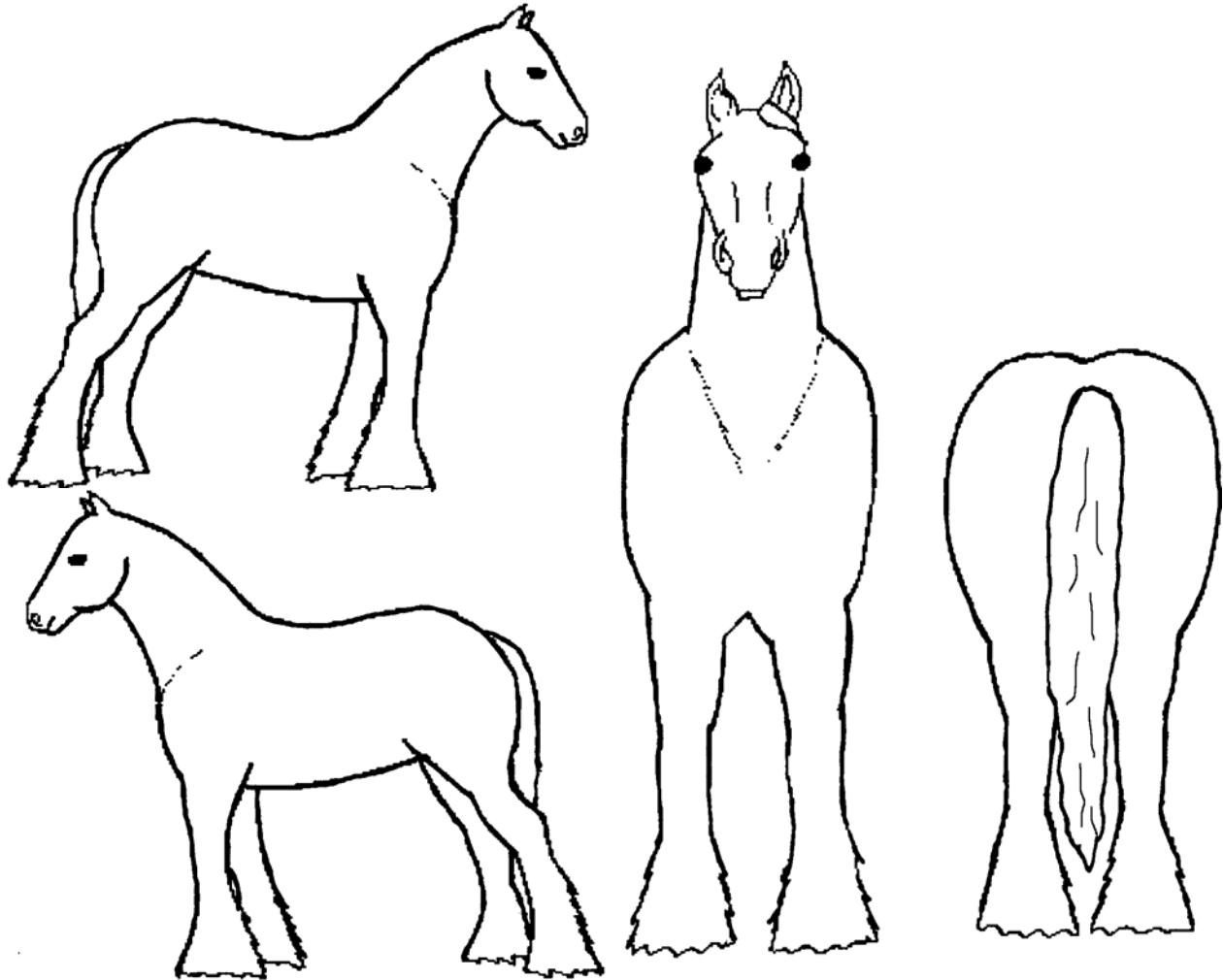

Registration Application Process

1. Please follow the instructions below to help facilitate the Registration approval process. Do not return this form with your registration application.
2. Please send completed registration form including drawings, 4 photos and your check or money order for registration made payable to the ADHA. (See fee schedule below)
3. This is only an application for registration with the ADHA. After your horse is approved for registration/certification with the ADHA the process will be complete ONLY upon processing and verification of a DNA sample. Once your horse has been accepted you will be asked to submit the included DNA form to the University of Kentucky for processing.
4. If your horse is already DNA tested with the University of Kentucky please submit a copy of the test results when you send this registration application to the ADHA. Horses with DNA already on record pay the lower registration/certification fee.

Photos:

- Photos must clearly show all four sides of the horse, full front, full left, full right, and full rear. Photos must include the horse's body from the head to the ground. Please write the horse's name, your name, address, and phone number on each photo. Photos will become the property of the ADHA, and will be kept on file with your registration information.
- Forelock should be braided and/or tucked to one side for the front shot. For the rear shot, please braid tail so that it is not obstructing the horse's rear legs. It is preferable that the horse's mane be braided for side shots in order to clearly show the horse's neck and shoulder conformation and markings. Any photos showing signs of graphic enhancements will be rejected.

DNA analysis:

- DNA must be submitted directly to the University of Kentucky for analysis.
- Please follow the directions on the form provided once the horse in question has been approved for registration/certification.
- If lineage is not known, the horse's DNA will be entered into the ADHA's database.
- If lineage is to be verified, the DNA sample submitted will be compared to the pedigree information supplied on the registry application.
- Please remember to supply registered names of all horses, or DNA may come back as "not matching."
