IDHA End of Year Award Program

All points must be in by January 15th.

The IDHA offers an End of the Year Point Award Program. Every year, the IDHA awards High Point for: Dressage, Show, Performance, Exhibition, Youth, Cicero and Janus. End of Year Awards include: a trophy and article in the Drum Beat. All Participants (**Both Adult & Youth**) in this program **MUST** be IDHA members in good standing! **All awards follow one horse and one rider.**

- Performance – This award is for horses competing in a particular discipline. Competitive driving, reining, eventing, etc.
- Show – This award encompasses IDHA sponsored shows as well as open breed shows attended throughout the year.
- Dressage – This award is given specifically for dressage shows.
- Cicero - This will be offered to horses through their second year (until their 3rd birthday) shown in hand. This applies to any IDHA sponsored show as well as open breed shows.
- Janus – This will be offered to horses three and four years of age in their early years under saddle. Once a horse has won this title they will be bumped up into the overall show/performance category. **Age as of January of the competing year.*
- Exhibition - This award is intended for the horse who has done the most to educate and expose the public to our breed each year by attending events such as Equine Affaire, parades, fairs (not showing but if a demo is done), demos etc. and it is not work related. Contact us if you have questions about a particular event.
- Youth - This award is for youth under the age of 18. Points follow the same youth and horse throughout the year.

Points System: Points are awarded to the horse and will follow the horse for the life of his show career. Points are based on number of placings. For example, if there were 6 ribbons awarded, and you receive first place, you will be awarded 6 points. If you receive 6th place, you receive 1 point. If you participate, and are not awarded any placing, you will receive 1 point. Points are doubled for Championship classes.

You will receive an additional two points if this is an IDHA sponsored show. So if you receive first place out of 6 ribbons, you will receive 8 points. If you simply participate but do not place, you will receive 3 points.

If you are representing the IDHA and have also organized the IDHA booth, that is 4 points. (Organizing the booth is defined as: setting up the booth space with the official banner and scheduling persons to man it).
